Privacy Policy

The International Association of Structures and Architecture – IASA is a scientific/technical association comprising members in 50 countries since 2016. The mission of the Association is to explore and to promote the merging of the fields of Structures and Architecture, encompassing all the aspects related with the recent advances in the art, practice and theory of teaching, researching, designing and building structures. To achieve its mission, IASA promote actions aiming the progress of all aspects of the theory and application of Structures and Architecture; organise the International Conference on Structures and Architecture (ICSA) every three-year intervals; co-sponsor or endorse other symposia and conferences.

To provide good services to its members, IASA stores personal information such as name, work contact and mailing details and organisation. IASA does not store any sensitive personal data such as religious preferences, political views, sexual orientation, and credit card details.

IASA will not sell users/members information, and will only share it with third parties as described in this document. With this policy, IASA privileges privacy and shows that it ensures, protects and maintains confidentiality. This policy applies to the entire organisation, all processes, and all parts, objects and data collections. This privacy policy is in line with the general policy of IASA and the relevant national and European laws and regulations. This privacy policy comes into immediate effect and will be evaluated regularly and revised if necessary. Changes to this policy will be published via IASA website and communication channels. Principles

IASA will safely treat personal data and respects the privacy of those involved. IASA commits to the following principles: lawfulness, fairness and transparency; personal data will be processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner; personal data are collected and processed only for specific, explicit and legitimate purposes and not further processed in a manner that is incompatible with those purposes.

Data minimization

IASA collects only data that is adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary with the purposes for which it is possessed.
